**ORDER**

On September 2, 2020, the Board of Supervisors of Mathews County, Virginia, voted to conduct a referendum pursuant to § 15.2-1812 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, an attested copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference, requesting this Court to enter an Order directing that an advisory referendum be held at the next general election on November 2, 2021 to ascertain the wishes of the voters of Mathews County as to whether or not the Board of Supervisors should be authorize the relocation of the Soldiers & Sailor's Monument located on the historic Court Green at the corner of Court and Church Streets in Mathews County, Virginia.

UPON CONSIDERATION THEREOF, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that the Petition be GRANTED and an advisory referendum SHALL be held at the next general election on November 2, 2021, pursuant to the provisions of Virginia Code §§ 24.2-682 and 24.2-684 as amended, at which time the qualified voters of Mathews County shall be allowed to consider a ballot presenting the following question:

QUESTION: Shall the Mathews County Board of Supervisors relocate the Soldier's & Sailor's Monument located at the corner of Court and Church Streets on the Historic Court Green?




